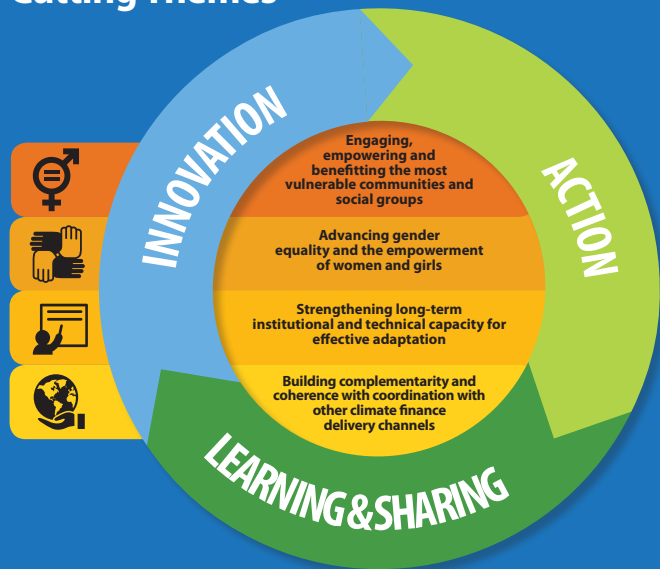


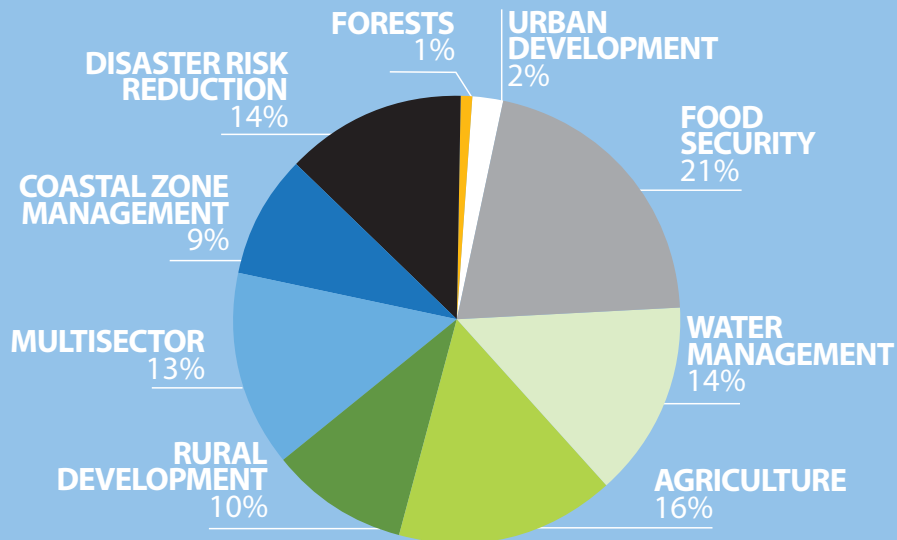

- Roadmap established by COP21
- Landmark CMP decision at COP23 that AF shall serve the Paris Agreement
- Serves the Paris Agreement as of Jan. 1, 2019, following a decision at COP24

Argentina Agriculture

Increasing adaptive capacity and building climate resilience of small-scale farmers



4,000 families equipped with adaptation measures and insurance plans



Fiji Urban Development

Increasing resilience of informal urban settlements that are vulnerable to climate change and disaster risks



6,000 residents (including 3,000 women) are trained for risk reduction actions or strategies



Cuba Coastal Management

Reduce impacts of coastal flooding through recovery of coastal ecosystems and forests



21,500 direct beneficiaries reduced coastal flooding (at least 45% women)



Regional Project Food Security

Developing and implementing adaptation strategies and measures for smallholder farmers in Ethiopia, Kenya, Uganda



45,000 farmers ensuring smart integration of climate information in agriculture practices
