## Pacific Islands Forum Delegation Begins In-Country Visit to Assess American Samoa's Membership Application

On Sunday, June 23, 2024, a delegation from the Pacific Islands Forum (PIF) arrived in the Territory to conduct the next phase of American Samoa's pending application for membership: the in-country visit.

The delegation includes His Excellency Ratu William Toganivalu, the Fiji Roving Ambassador to Pacific Island Countries and Territories and Agencies of the Council of Regional Organizations of the Pacific, and Mr. Teanuanua Nicole, Governance Officer from the PIF Secretariat. Both delegation members are based in Suva.

The in-country visit will take place from June 24 to June 26, 2024. The purpose of the visit is for the Forum to perform an internal assessment of how American Samoa's governance institutions, programs, and services align with the Pacific Islands Forum vision and mission, particularly the thematic areas of the 2050 Strategy for the Blue Pacific Continent. These areas include: Political Leadership and Regionalism, People-Centered Development, Peace and Security, Resources and Economic Development, Climate Change and Disasters, Ocean and Environment, and Technology and Connectivity.

Over the next three days, the PIF delegation will engage in high-level discussions with governance stakeholders from the American Samoa Government, as well as the private and non-governmental organization (NGO) sectors, and will attend site visits to gather relevant data for the Territory's PIF application.

The in-country visit begins Monday morning with a daily devotional Lotu at the Governor's Office conference room and an *Ava Feiloaiga* at the *Suigaulaoleatuvasa* in Utulei, organized by the Office of Samoan Affairs. High-level discussions with leaders from the government, private, and NGO sectors, along with site visits, will constitute the main program for the delegation.
