Austria, was subject of investigation conducted by Region VIII in May 59 under
dossier no. 14-013087. SI conducted on Beer, applicant for ICCP, disclosed
no derog info. DEER was at that time assigned as Chief of USI Agency
Processing Team and opel facility located 742 KUNIGUNDE Clayallee, Berlin/
Johannstadt, and as Civilian Deputy Berlin Element, 512th AIG. Updated card
indicated negative SAC check conducted per fax req HQX dtd 25 Feb 59.

City. Card in dossier case opened on KNACKSTERN under Region VIII file
no. VIII-27754 in April 1959 for clearance access to confidential info. Lead

16-Lie/Sterlitz, Albrechtstr 11d, was subj local name check req by AIG (sic)
on 7 July 59. Negative present said of DEER.
