#### LIFE

- 1. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: divestment; abortion; explicit material (SB 1146) Prohibits state investments or donations to organizations that support abortions for minors or sexually explicit materials in public K-12 schools. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 5, 2023.
- 2. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: infants; born alive; (SB 1600) Extends protections to all infants born alive and holds accountable health professionals who fail to provide these children with needed care. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 32-26-2. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 6, 2023.
- 3. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: domestic violence; pregnant victim (HB 2427) Increases the penalty for a person guilty of aggravated assault if he or she commits a crime while having reason to believe the victim was pregnant. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-28-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 3, 2023.
- 4. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: substance exposure; pregnant women (HB 2530) Provides treatment for pregnant women using dangerous drugs. Passed Senate 17-13. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs May 19, 2023.
- 5. CAP Action-OPPOSED: Equal Rights Amendment Procedural vote to vote on ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA), that would enshrine abortion in the U.S. Constitution. Motion failed 16-12-2 in the Senate and 31-29 in the House.



#### MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

- 6. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: pronouns; school policies (SB 1001) Requires written parental consent for school personnel to use name or pronoun that is contrary to the student's biological sex. Protects conscience rights of school personnel from being forced to call students by a name or pronoun that does not coincide with the student's biological sex. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs May 19, 2023.
- 7. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: state monies; drag shows; minors (SB 1026) Ensures taxpayer dollars are not used to pay for drag shows targeting minors. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 16, 2023.
- 8. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: adult cabaret performances; (SB 1028) Prohibits cabaret performances, including drag shows, on public property and in view of children. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 16, 2023
- 9. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: sexually explicit performances (SB 1030) Applies Arizona adult businesses statutes to drag shows, including being licensed as other adult-oriented businesses. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 16, 2023.
- 10. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: public schools; reasonable accommodations (SB 1040) Requires schools to supply reasonable accommodations for students who say they identify as other than their biological sex. Requires access to a single-occupancy facility to anyone who is unwilling or unable to use the restroom or locker room of their biological sex. Passed Senate 16-14. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 8, 2023.
- 11. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: race; ethnicity; prohibited instruction (SB 1305) Prohibits public schools and state agencies from teaching or promoting critical race theory. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-29. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs March 9, 2023.
- 12. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: unlawful exposure; minors; sentencing; reporting (SB 1698) Establishes unlawful exposure to an adult-oriented performance or business as a class 4 felony offense punishable as a dangerous crime against children and requires a person convicted of the offense to register as a sex offender. Passed Senate 16-14. Passed House 31-26-2-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 16, 2023.
- 13. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: teacher training; parental notification; requirements (HB 2786) Mandates a school district governing board (governing board) or charter school governing body develop parental notification and access procedures if the school district or charter school is involved with a training for teachers or administrators. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-29. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 16, 2023.

### **RELIGIOUS FREEDOM**

- 14. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: student activity fees; conscience exemption (SB 1145) Gives students an exemption from paying student activity fees that violate the student's conscience on religious or moral grounds. Passed Senate 16-14. Failed House 28-30-2 (RECONSIDERATION).
- 15. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: employers; vaccines; religious exemption (SB 1250) Requires employers to allow employees to claim a religious exemption from taking the COVID-19 vaccination. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-29. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs March 30, 2023.
- 16. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: sexually explicit materials; government; prohibition (SB 1696) Prohibits the state from exposing minors to "sexually explicit materials." Passed Senate 16-14. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 5, 2023.
- 17. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: private school students; interscholastic activities (SB 1564) Allows students in small private schools to play sports at their local public school Passed Senate 16-13-1. Failed House 30-28-1-1.
- 18. CAP Action- OPPOSED: Empowerment Scholarship Account Limitations (Budget item amendment) Proposed amendment to limit enrollment in the Empowerment Scholarship Account program. Failed Senate 14-16. Failed House 27-31-1.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- 19. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: STOs; individual income tax credits (SB 1243) Simplifies the two individual scholarship tax credit programs. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 8, 2023.
- 20. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: initiative; referendum; signatures; legislative districts (SCR 1015) Ask voters to approve a state constitutional amendment to require initiative proponents to obtain signatures from every legislative district. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-29.
