<p>Does the club link to the Bowls England approved safeguarding policy for Adults on their website?</p> <p>Best Practice: The club should have a section for safeguarding available on the front loading page in a prominent position, under this there should be a link to this page</p>	
<p>Does the website include what to do in the event of a concern or disclosure?</p> <p>Best Practice: The club should have details for the club safeguarding officer and the NGB Lead Safeguarding officer, it might be useful to include a link to this document.</p>	
<p>Does the website include a copy of the clubs code of conduct?</p> <p>Best Practice: This should be for club members, coaches, officials, volunteers, parents, carers, spectators etc. This should include; Anti-Bullying, Social Media Policy, Photography Policy...</p>
