# Planned realisation and outcomes

Future challenges from a scientific and technological point of view are seen as (1) the holistic and cascading use of renewable raw materials, (2) the increasing demands on functionality and properties of materials and products, and (3) new process technologies that take into account the aspects of the circular economy including recycling.

The research programme "WOOD - TRANSITION TO A SUSTAINABLE BIOECONOMY" takes up these challenges and aims at (1) new or improved production processes, (2) new bio-based products and materials, (3) new or improved methods (e.g. in analytics) with a (4) higher resource efficiency (saving of raw materials, energy, machine load and personnel). The targeted innovations should make a significant contribution to the sustainability and strengthening of the bioeconomy, as the participating partner companies use them in their production plants and successfully market the resulting products on an international level.

# History of establishment

The centre was founded in 2001 as a non-profit organisation within the framework of the K plus programme. (2001 - 2007). Subsequently, the work as a COMET K1 centre was continued from 2008 - 2014 and then 2015 − 2022. The Non COMET area was built up with many national and international research projects to a volume of over € 4.5 million per year. Currently, more than 120 employees work at Wood K plus for over 100 corporate partners together with a large network of renowned scientific institutions.
