Has the marriage already occurred?

This form is to order a marriage certificate after a marriage has occurred and been registered. If you want to apply for a marriage licence, go to <u>marriages.services.govt.nz</u>.

If the marriage is not registered in New Zealand you need to order your certificate from the country where it is registered.

Do you want to use the certificate outside New Zealand?

When you need to use a New Zealand certificate in another country, you might be asked to get the document apostilled or authenticated. Apostilles and authentications are certificates that prove the signature, stamp or seal on a document is genuine.

If you want to use the certificate overseas, go to govt.nz/authentications to find more information.

Do you need a certificate or a copy of the record?

You can order a certificate or a copy of the record. A certificate is a legal official document. A copy of the record contains more information than a certificate and is usually used for research purposes.

Are you researching family history?

If you want to order a certificate or a copy of the record for a historical marriage, you can do this at <u>bdmhistoricalrecords.dia.govt.nz</u>.

A historical marriage is a marriage or civil union that occurred 75 years ago or more.
