PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

KARADŽIĆ case

Trial Chamber III – Judges Kwon (Presiding), Morrison, Baird and Lattanzi (Reserve Judge)

Continuation of the Prosecution case

On 31 October and 1 November 2011, the following witness testified:

- *Mirsad Mujadžić (President of the SDA party in Prijedor/BiH politician during the relevant period)*

On 1 and 2 November 2011, the following witness testified:

- *Witness KDZ-163 (testifying about the “Manjača” camp during the relevant period)*

On 3 November 2011, the following witnesses testified:

- *Nenad Krejić (Chief of police in Skender Vakuf during the relevant period)*
- *Milan Komljenović (President of the municipal assembly and the Crisis Staff in Skender Vakuf during the relevant period)*

HARADINAJ *et al.* case

Trial Chamber II – Judges Moloto (Presiding), Hall and Delvoie

Continuation of the Prosecution case

From 31 October until 2 November 2011, the following witness testified:

- *Witness 3 (eyewitness from Kosovo/detained at the “Jablanica” detention facility during the relevant period)*

From 2 until 4 November 2011, the following witnesses testified (*continuation from 31 August 2011*):

- *Witness 75 (brother of a person detained at the “Jablanica” detention facility during the relevant period)*

The trial is adjourned until 21 November 2011.

Trial Chamber judgement

On 31 October 2011, the Chamber rendered its judgement and sentenced Šešelj to 18 months' imprisonment – *See Press Release number 1456, dated 31 October 2011.*

Further initial appearance

On 4 November 2011, the parties met before Judge Hall for the further appearance of Šešelj. Since the accused did not enter a plea, Judge Hall informed him that, under the Rules, he would have to do so within 10 days.

ORDONNANCE PORTANT CALENDRIER (MEMOIRES EN CLOTURE, REQUISITOIRE ET PLAIDOIRIE FINALE)

On 31 October 2011, the Chamber ordered that:

- final trial briefs should be filed by 5 February 2012 at the latest and should not exceed 200 pages;
- the Prosecution's closing arguments would be heard from 5 March 2012, followed by the accused's closing arguments;
- Ten hours would be allotted to each side for their closing arguments.
