#### **WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO REPORT GERMANY TO UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL**

On 3 September 2012 (made public on 6 September), the Defence withdrew its motion to report Germany to the UN Security Council because Christoph von Bezold, a German citizen and a former member of the ECMM in Zagreb, voluntarily submitted to an interview by Karadzic's legal advisor in Munich on 31 August 2012.

#### **VERSION PUBLIQUE ET EXPURGÉE DE LA “DÉCISION PORTANT SUR LA REQUÊTE DE SLOBODAN PRALJAK RELATIVE À SA MISE EN LIBERTÉ PROVISOIRE”**

On 5 September 2012, the Chamber ordered Praljak to return to the UN Detention Unit in The Hague. Judge Antonetti partially dissented.
