Vidoje BLAGOJEVIĆ case

ICTY President Meron

**DECISION OF THE PRESIDENT ON EARLY RELEASE OF VIDOJE
BLAGOJEVIĆ**

On 27 December 2012, the decision granting early release to Vidoje Blagojevic was made public. The original (confidential) decision was made on 3 February 2012, when President Meron granted the motion for early release to Blagojevic based on the following conclusions: Blagojević has served the two thirds of his sentence, his role in the commission of the crimes in Srebrenica was limited but nevertheless extremely high and he demonstrated a degree of rehabilitation in the prison in Norway. He was first to be released on 31 December 2012 but then the Norwegian authorities requested another date - 22 December due to logistic reasons. The President granted it and ordered that Blagojević be released on 22 December 2012.
