PUBLIC REDACTED VERSION OF THE 30 APRIL 2014 DECISION OF THE PRESIDENT ON THE EARLY RELEASE OF RANKO ČEŠIĆ

On 28 May 2014 (public redacted version of the decision), MICT President Meron granted early release to Ranko Češić effective 25 May this year. Češić completed two-thirds of the sentence, demonstrated signs of rehabilitation and cooperated with the Office of the Prosecutor, based on which President Meron decided in favor of early release.
