# DECISION ON DEFENCE INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL FROM THE TRIAL CHAMBER RULE 98 BIS DECISION

On 24 July 2014, The Appeals Chamber (AC) dismissed the Defence Interlocutory Appeal from the Trial Chamber (TC) Rule 98bis ruling. At the outset the AC noted that Mladić Defence requested certification to appeal the Impugned Decision as far as it related to the TC's findings on his genocidal intent and the TC's reliance on OTP Witnesses RM255 and RM019. However, the TC granted Defence certification to appeal the Impugned Decision with respect to Counts 1 and 2 (Genocide), and consequently in reaching its decision the AC considered the totality of the Appeal.
