The parties delivered their closing arguments and Dragan Nikolić gave a statement. The Prosecution suggested a sentence of 15 years' imprisonment. The Sentencing Judgement will be rendered on 18 December 2003.

Vladimir KOVAČEVIĆ Case ("Dubrovnik")

On 3 November 2003, following Vladimir Kovačević's transfer to the Tribunal on 23 October 2003, the parties appeared before the Trial Chamber for his initial appearance. Due to medical problems, the Accused did not enter a plea.

DECISION ON JOINT DEFENCE MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF PROVISIONAL RELEASE AND SCHEDULING ORDER

On 31 October 2003, the Trial Chamber granted the 28 October 2003 Joint Defence Motion to allow both Accused to surrender to the custody of the Tribunal not sooner than five days before the commencement of their trial. It ordered that both Accused shall surrender to the custody of the Tribunal on Thursday 27 November 2003 and that the Pre-Trial Conference be rescheduled to 28 November 2003 at 9 a.m. in Courtroom III.

Bench of the Appeals Chamber – Judges Schomburg (Presiding), Güney and Weinberg de Roca DECISIONS ON FATMIR LIMAJ'S, HARADIN BALA'S AND ISAK MUSLIU'S REQUESTS FOR PROVISIONAL RELEASE

On 31 October 2003, in three separate Decisions, a Bench of the Appeals Chamber denied leave to appeal the three impugned Decisions denying the three co-Accused provisional release.
