PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

MILUTINOVIĆ et al. Case

Trial Chamber III - Judges Bonomy (Presiding), Chowhan, Kamenova and Nosworthy (Reserve Judge)

Completion of the Prosecution case - Rule 98bis submissions

On 1 May 2007, the Prosecution rested its case.

From 1 May until 4 May 2007, the parties presented oral submissions pursuant to Rule 98bis.

POPOVIĆ et al. Case (“Srebrenica”)

Trial Chamber II - Judges Agius (Presiding), Kwon, Prost and Støle (Reserve Judge)

Continuation of the Prosecution case

On 1 May 2007, the following witnesses were examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence:

- *Danko Gojković* (officer of the Republika Srpska Army during the relevant period)-
continuation from 27 April; the witness was only cross-examined
- *Stanoje Birčaković* (officer of the Republika Srpska Army during the relevant period)

From 1 May until 3 May 2007, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence:

- *Mendeljev Đurić* (member of the Republika Srpska Special Police Brigade)

On 4 May 2007, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence:

- *Dražen Erdemović* (member of the Republika Srpska Army in Srebrenica; sentenced by the ICTY in 1998)- *the witness testified with facial and voice distortion*

Trial Chamber III – Judges Antonetti (Presiding), Prandler, Trechsel and Mindua (Reserve Judge)

Continuation of the Prosecution case

Trial Chamber III – Judges Robinson (Presiding), Mindua and Harhoff

Completion of the Prosecution case - Rule 98bis judgement

On 1 May 2007, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution, subsequently cross-examined by the Defence and then re-examined by the Prosecution:

- *Hussein Ijaz* (member of UN Military Observers -UNMO in Sarajevo during the relevant period)

From 1 May until 2 May 2007, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution, subsequently cross-examined by the Defence and then re-examined by the Prosecution:

- *Ewa Tabeau* (demographer – ICTY/OTP staff member)

On 2 May 2007, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence:

- *Barry Hogan* (ICTY/OTP staff member)

This was the last witness for the Prosecution and they rested their case.

On 3 May 2007, the parties presented oral submissions pursuant to Rule 98bis. During this session, the Trial Chamber dismissed Rule 98bis motion for acquittal of Dragomir Milošević.

The trial is scheduled to resume on 24 May 2007.
