DECISION ON MOTION BY WITNESS 28 TO SET ASIDE SUBPOENA OR FOR ALTERNATIVE RELIEF

On 5 September 2007, Trial Chamber I dismissed a motion by Witness 28 to have the subpoena, served on her on 13 August, set aside, or, in the alternative, to have her testimony received in closed session. The witness is ordered to comply with the subpoena and to appear to give testimony in this case on a date to be communicated to her by the Registry.

DECISION ON PROSECUTION'S MOTION SEEKING LEAVE TO AMEND THE REVISED SECOND AMENDED INDICTMENT

On 5 September 2007, pursuant to Article 19 of the Statute and Rule 50 of the Rules, Trial Chamber I granted a motion by the Prosecution and ordered that the revised third amended indictment shall be the operative indictment in this case.

DECISION ON STANIŠIĆ DEFENCE'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY MODIFICATION OF PROVISIONAL RELEASE CONDITIONS

On 5 September 2007, pursuant to Rules 54 and 65 of the Rules, Trial Chamber III granted a motion by Jovica Stanišić and ordered that he may leave Belgrade for the Igalo Institute in Montenegro for the sole purpose of receiving medical treatment for a period of no more than three consecutive weeks beginning 16 September 2007, or as soon as practical thereafter, but beginning no later than 30 September 2007.
