The aim of the company is to make local news easily accessible on all devices, particularly mobile, without intrusive pop-up advertising, enforced surveys or clickbait. We will ensure that our content remains truly local.

We provide local news, community news, what's on, local business listings, classifieds, jobs, property and obituaries - all the staples of a good local newspaper.

Currently we operate just over 50 websites with more launches planned for April/May 2023.

New titles will launch shortly in St Albans and Stockport. Other launches will follow through 2023.

We currently employ 21 journalists who are located across the country and a back up staff including a small sales team based at our Crewe.

Our editorial standards

Nub News agrees to abide by the guidance, rules and regulations of IPSO and to adhere to the Editor's Code of Conduct as prescribed the organisation.

Each reporter/regional editor is responsible for his/her own 'patch' which may include up to three towns. All reporters/regional editors take part in twice-weekly group conferences at which a wide range of matters including training and best practice are discussed.

Any complaints about stories should be initially made to the report/editor and if a satisfactory conclusion cannot be reached then the matter is elevated to the jurisdiction of the Editorial Director, currently Neil Speight.

Should any complaint not be resolved, at that level the complainant has the right of appeal to the CEO – and, of course, to IPSO.


The editorial director regularly briefs staff on relevant issues in the Code and several times a year gives legal and procedural briefings to the team.

All staff are contractually bound to adhere to the Editor's Code.

All complaints that are elevated beyond level one, ie with the reporter/regional editor are logged by the Editorial director.

Information is freely available on all sites about how to complain and about accessing IPSO.

The majority of staff employed as journalists by Nub News have graduated through an NCTJ training process. We work closely with training providers including the NCTJ, News Associates and The PA>

Our writers are expected to adhere to all standard processes, ie pre-publication checks with expert sources, fact-checking of articles before publication and seeking legal advice when necessary.

Transparency

All appropriate details of the company's transactions are posted at Companies House. Details of financial transparency and conflict of interest policies.

Compliance

There has been one complaint referred to IPSO in the past year which was found not to be valid.

In addition IPSO is currently about to rule on a complaint relating to Hadleigh Nub News and its editor Derek Davies.

In the past year there have been no instances where Nub News has accepted that it breached the Editors' Code.

Training.

Several of our reporters/regional editors have not yet reached 'senior' status but a number are expected to undertake formal NCTJ-recognised qualification within the next two years.
