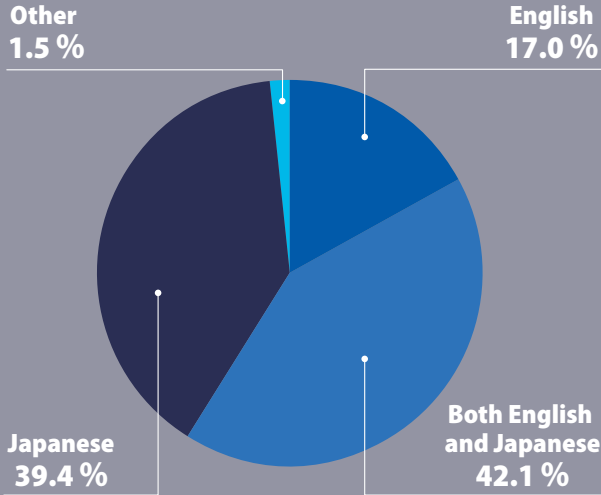

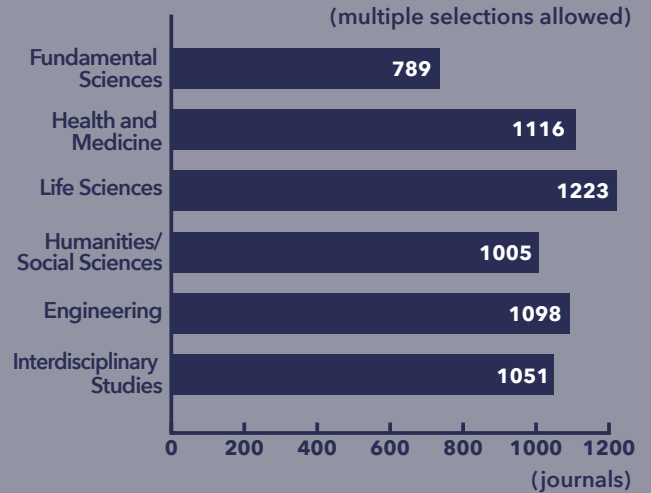


Multiple language options
