Russia Sanctions (Russian Armed Forces) Designation Notice 2022 (No 1)

Title

1. This is the Russia Sanctions (Russian Armed Forces) Designation Notice 2022 (No 1).

Effective Date

2. This notice comes into effect on the day after it has been notified in the New Zealand Gazette.

Authority

- 3. This notice is secondary legislation given under section 11 of the Russia Sanctions Act 2022 ("the Act") by the Secretary of Foreign Affairs and Trade after being satisfied of the matters set out in that section, and has legal effect.
- 4. This notice is given to assist users of the Russia Sanctions Regulations 2022 ("the Regulations") made under section 9 of the Act, by providing further details of who or what is covered by a description of a class in the Regulations.
- 5. Part 3 of Schedule 2 of the Regulations provides a description of the following class of persons who are sanctioned by regulations 10, 10A, and 11.

A branch or an independent arm of service of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, including Logistical Support of the Russian Armed Forces

Designated Persons

- 6. The persons identified in Annex 1 of this notice:
 - a. are a branch or an independent arm of service of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, including Logistical Support of the Russian Armed Forces; and
 - b. meet the description of that class of persons; and
 - c. are designated persons.
- 7. The <u>Russia Sanctions Register</u> maintained under section 14 of the Act will be updated to include these designated persons.

Revocation

8. This notice is revoked at the close of 17 March 2025.
