

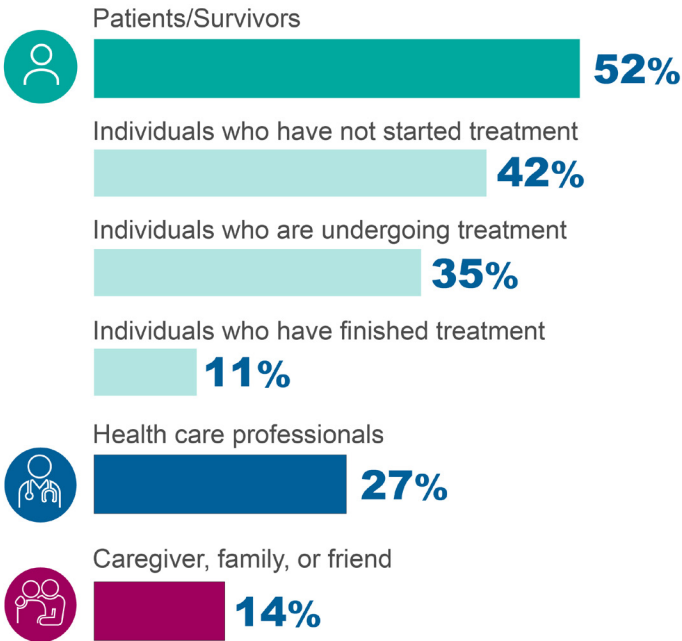

NCCN Guidelines for Patients®

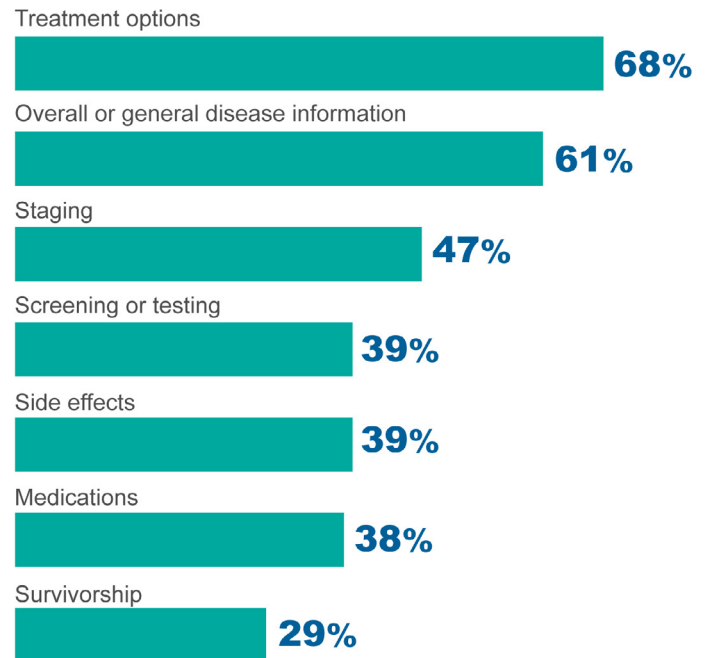
In 2020, NCCN Guidelines for Patients were downloaded **2.2 million times** and accessed by over **1.5 million unique individuals**.

The following data represent survey results from May - December 2020.

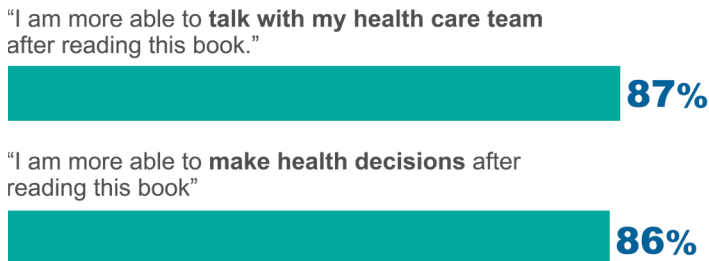
NCCN Guidelines for Patients are used by:

The 2020 NCCN Guidelines User Survey assesses opinions of U.S. registered users of the NCCN clinical practice guidelines.

80% of surveyed clinicians were familiar with the NCCN Guidelines for Patients.



Nurses are the discipline that most often refers people with cancer to NCCN Guidelines for Patients.

60% of respondents state that they use and/or refer their patients to the NCCN Guidelines for Patients.

YIA awardees receive funding to advance important research on issues in oncology. These early-career investigators from NCCN Member Institutions represent tomorrow's leaders for advancing cancer care.

\$8.7 million awarded to **59** investigators to date for advancing cancer research.
