1. **NAME OF THE SUBJECT:-** Corrigendum of Resolution Item No. 11(E-02) with regard to levying of user charges for collection of Solid Waste.

2. **NAME OF THE DEPARTMENT:**

Public Health Department

3. **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE SUBJECT:-**

Adoption of Solid waste Management Rules 2016 by New Delhi Municipal Council vide resolution No. 11 (E-02) dated 26.04.2016 is in accordance with directions from Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India. It is mandated that NDMC shall prescribe from time to time user fees as deemed appropriate and collect the fee from the waste generators for the sustainability of collection, transportation, processing and disposal of solid waste.

Council has already approved agenda for Collection of user charges from Waste generators vide Item No. 11(E-02) in its Meeting 26/04/16. The Council Decision is as follows:

"Whereas the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate change, Government of India, in exercise of the power conferred under sections 3,6 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) act 1986, notified the Solid Waste Management Rules 2016 vide notification No. S.O. 1357(E) Dated 08th April 2016.

And Whereas, Rule 15 of Solid Waste Management Rules 2016 w.r.t. Duties and responsibilities of local authorities and village panchayat of census towns and urban agglomerations' inter-alia states that the local authority shall prescribe time to time user fee as deemed appropriate and collect the fee from the waste generators on its own or through authorized agency(sub rule(f)).

Therefore, the Council resolved to accord approval in principal for levying user charges for lifting and transportation of solid waste from domestic/commercial/ institutional/ any other areas of NDMC under the provisions of sub-rule (f) of rule 15 of the Solid Waste Management rules 2016.
