St. Lucie County Election Office Conducts Voter Outreach with National Federation of the Blind Treasure Coast Chapter

The St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections office is partnering with the National Federation of the Blind Treasure Coast Chapter to conduct voter outreach and education on the accessible features of the voting equipment and process. The outreach event will take place on Saturday, May 18, 2024, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the WQCS radio station located at the Indian River State College (IRSC) Fort Pierce campus on 3209 Virginia Avenue.

The event will feature a demonstration of the accessible voting machines, as well as information on how to register to vote, update voter information, request a vote-by-mail ballot, and locate polling places. The attendees will also have the opportunity to interact with Rosemary Brunson, President of the National Federation of the Blind Treasure Coast Chapter, who will share her experience and feedback on the accessibility of the voting system.
