Keeping Children Safe training is aimed at anyone working or volunteering with children and young people.

Keeping Children Safe Module 1: An Introduction

3
HOURS
£30

Suitable for **staff/volunteers who have limited and/or indirect contact** with children and young people (e.g. cleaner, receptionist), it covers:

- legal context for keeping children safe
- types of abuse including online, grooming and exploitation
- procedures for reporting concerns
- code of behaviour for staff/volunteers e.g. e-safety issues.

Module 1 stands alone but it is recommended that those working more directly and frequently with children and young people should consider any of the additional modules.

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Module 3: Training for Managers, Supervisors and Management Committees

Suitable for **those in management** within groups/organisations that provide activities for children and young people, **it covers Module 1 content PLUS:**

- recruitment, selection and management of staff/volunteers
- confidentiality issues and breach of code of behaviour
- dealing with allegations against staff/volunteers.

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Module 4: Safeguarding Children on Day Trips and Residentials

Suitable for those who are **new to taking children/young people away on day trips and residentials**. It can be delivered **with or after Module 1**, it covers:

- planning a day trip or residentials
- safeguarding scenarios away from home
- procedures for running safer activities
- steps to protect all involved.

Keeping Children Safe Module 2:

Training for Staff and Volunteers

HOURS
£45

Suitable for **staff/volunteers who have regular and/or direct contact with children and young people** (e.g. childcare worker, support worker, coach, activity leader/supervisor), **it covers Module 1 content PLUS:**

- planning activities and risk assessment
- creating a safe child-centred environment
- practical steps to protect staff/volunteers
- code of behaviour for young people.

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Module 5: Safeguarding Children with Disabilities

Suitable for **staff/volunteers working with children and young people with disabilities**, **it covers Module 1 content PLUS:**

- disability models
- attitudes to disability
- safeguarding procedures when e.g. mobility or communication is restricted
- creating safe and inclusive environments.

Keeping Children Safe Module 6: Policy Development

3
HOURS
£30

Suitable for individuals with responsibility for developing and/or reviewing safeguarding children policy and procedures, it covers.

- the 7 standards of best practice for safeguarding children/young people
- a guide to developing a safeguarding children policy
- procedures to support a safeguarding children policy.

While not essential, having prior knowledge of safeguarding children is beneficial e.g. attendance at modules 1 or 2.

Keeping Children Safe Module 7: Training for Designated Officers

6
HOURS
£75

Suitable for **Designated and Deputy Designated Officers**. All participants **must** have completed training on safeguarding children prior to attending this course e.g. Module 2 or 3. It covers:

- legal context for safeguarding children
- role and responsibilities of a Designated Officer
- Health and Social Care Trust structures and processes
- exploration of issues and concerns around referrals and sharing information.

Keeping Children Safe Initiatives

Refresher courses available!
