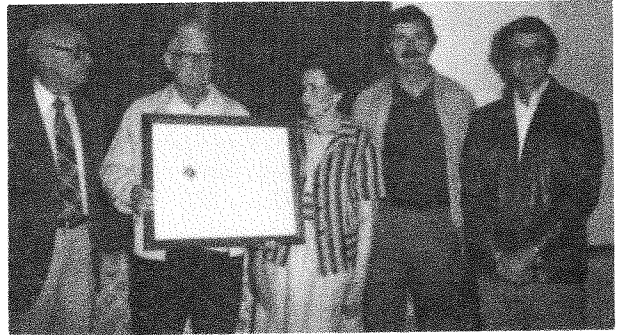

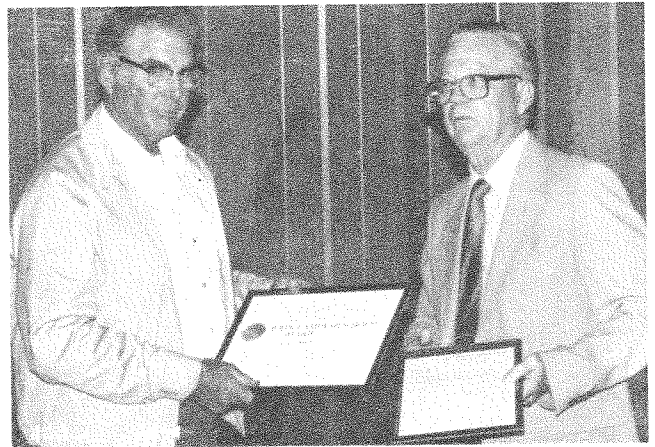

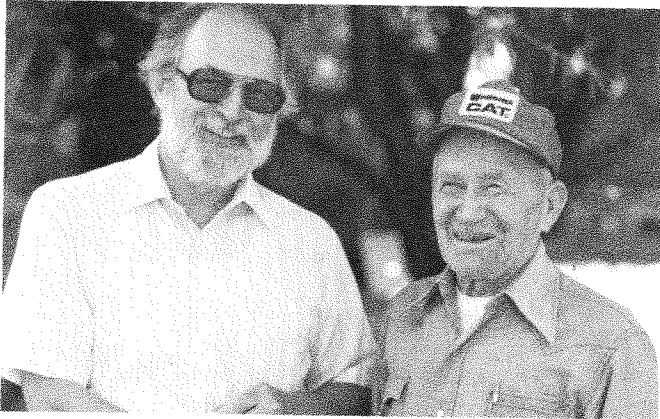

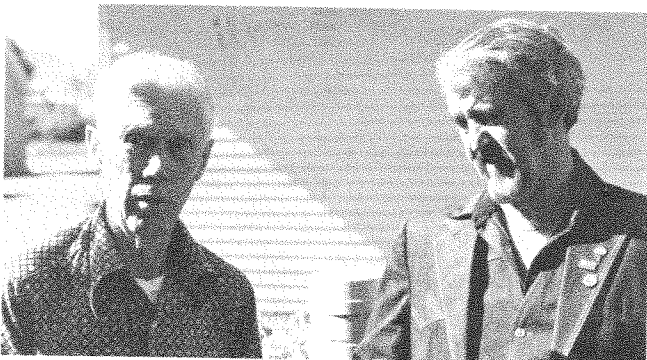

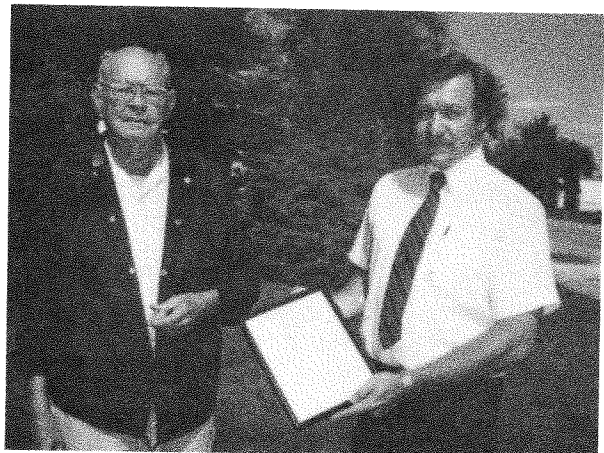

DEL NORTE, CO



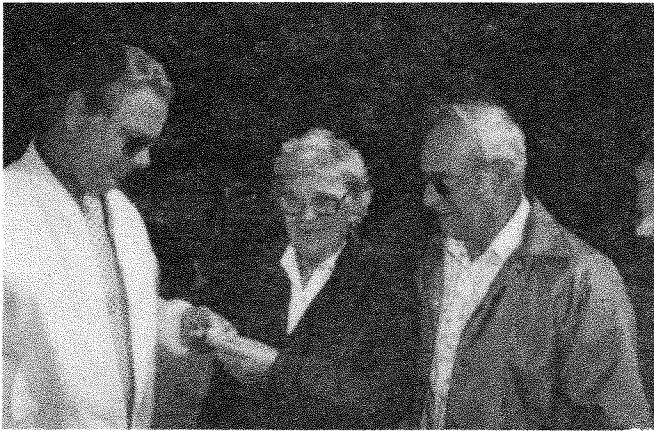

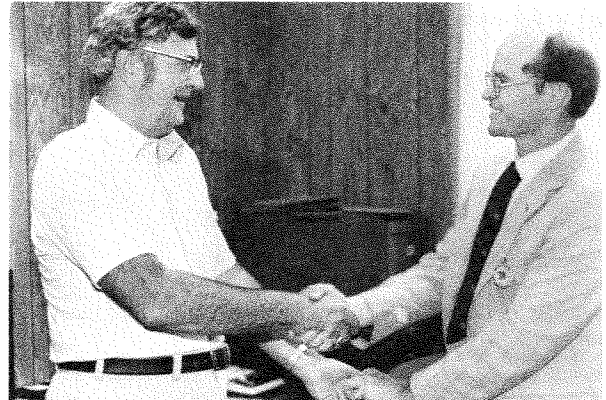

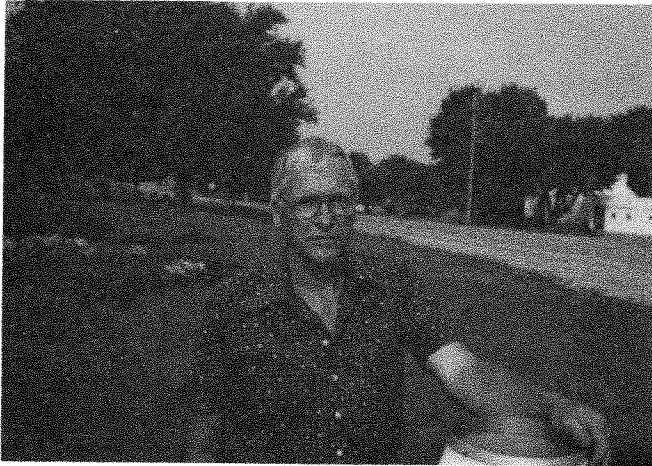

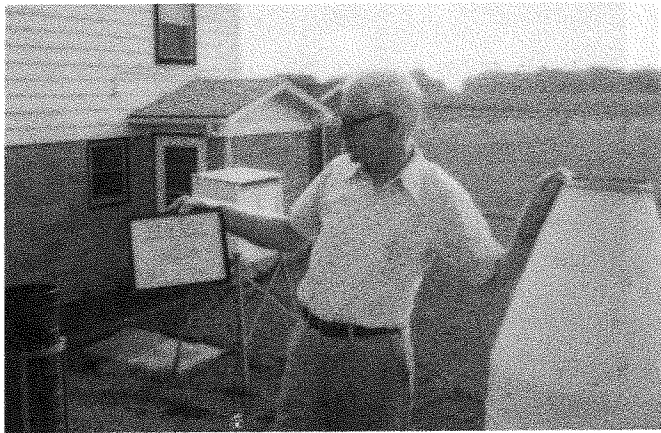

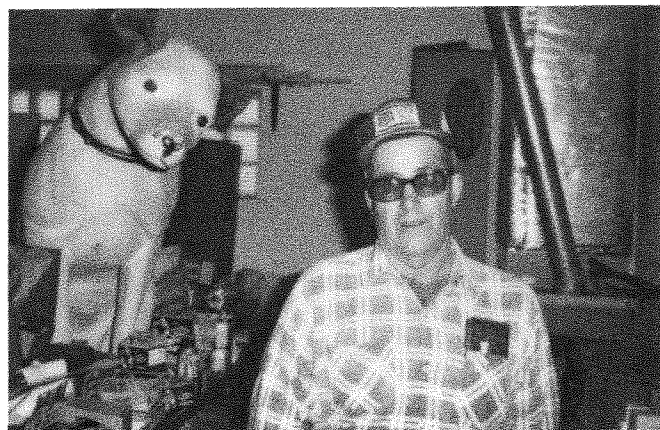
