Appendix

A **suspect case** is any person (alive or dead):

- Suffering or having suffered from a sudden onset of high fever **AND**
- Having had contact with an Ebola case or a dead or sick animal

OR

- With a sudden onset of high fever **AND**
- With at least three of the following symptoms:
 - Headache
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - Anorexia/loss of appetite
 - Lethargy
 - Stomach pain
 - Aching muscles or joints
 - Difficulty swallowing
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Hiccups

OR

- With unexplained bleeding/hemorrhaging

OR

- With sudden unexplained death

OR

- Clinical suspicion of Ebola
