ESTABLISHMENT OF THE OFFICES OF THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER AND THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF, G-6

- 1. Effective 11 August 2020, the Office of the United States Army Chief Information Officer/G-6 (UIC: W4NJAA) is disestablished and two separate organizations are established:
- a. the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) (UIC: W4NJAA), led by the Chief Information Officer (CIO), a Principal Official of Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA), in the Army Secretariat
- b. the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-6 (ODCS, G-6) (UIC: W0FUAA), led by the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-6 (DCS, G-6), a Principal Official of HQDA on the Army Staff
- 2. The CIO is the principal advisor to the Secretary of the Army responsible for exercising overall supervision for information management. This function includes information technology (IT) policy; Cloud and IT governance; and Information Resource Management, including Enterprise IT for worldwide Army operations, the Enterprise IT architecture, and Cyber Security policy, which includes cyber policy for networks.
- 3. The DCS, G-6 is the principal military advisor to the Chief of Staff of the Army and the CIO for planning, strategy, network architecture, and implementation of command, control, communications, cyber operations and networks for worldwide Army operations.
- 4. These changes will be incorporated into the next revision to Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 01, dated 6 March 2020.
