## REDESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORRECTIONS COMMAND AND ITS SUBORDINATE ELEMENTS AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT

**1.** Effective 1 April 2023, the United States Army Corrections Command (ACC) (UIC: W6L2AA) is redesignated as a direct reporting unit of the Office of the Provost Marshal General (OPMG) (UIC: W6EKAA).

**2**. In conjunction with this action, ACC will consolidate the manpower and equipment of its subordinate 15th Military Police (MP) Brigade onto a single table of distribution and allowances under the ACC UIC, and the 15th MP Brigade (UIC: W6L3AA) will inactivate effective 1 April 2023.

**3.** The Commanding General, ACC will exercise all authority, direction, command, and control over ACC and oversight of the Army Corrections System (ACS) in coordination with the Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) staff and Army commands pursuant to this order and applicable regulations.

**4.** HQDA will continue supporting the ACS in executing the Army's statutory and operational responsibilities to provide a uniform system of incarceration and correctional services for military prisoners in Army custody.

**5.** Senior commanders of installations on which United States Army corrections facilities are located will continue enduring support relationships.

**6.** The Assistant Secretary of the Army for Manpower and Reserve Affairs continues to exercise Army Secretariat oversight for Army corrections, parole, and clemency functions.
