DESIGNATION OF MILITARY SURFACE DEPLOYMENT AND DISTRIBUTION COMMAND AS AN ARMY SERVICE COMPONENT COMMAND

- 1. Effective 16 October 2006, the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command (SDDC) (UIC: W0QFAA) is hereby designated as an Army Service Component Command (ASCC) to the U.S. Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM) and as a Major Subordinate Command of the U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC).
- 2. SDDC provides surface deployment and distribution planning and operations from point of origin to deployed forces in theaters of operation in support of Department of Defense strategic mobility, contingency, and deployment planning and military operations. SDDC is an operational-level Army Force designated by the Secretary of the Army as an ASCC of USTRANSCOM. SDDC exercises administrative control authority and responsibility over Army forces; this control flows from the Secretary of the Army through the Commander, AMC. SDDC exercises operational control over Army Forces, as delegated by the Commander, USTRANSCOM.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of HQDA General Orders No. 5, dated 30 April 2004, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
