Hazard	Control
Foul waste leak/overspill Contact with Hazardous Materials	 Foul waste tanks specced to double the required size to never reach full capacity for one studio show with full audience Tank level meters installed in to monitor levels and inspected regularly Tanks emptied regularly by licensed contractor Licensed drainage contractor on 24 hour call-out 3 separate tanks to enable locking off of one portacabin and repurpose others if 1 tank is not useable Cubicles/Portacabins to be locked-off with signage/barriers to prevent access Cleaners on site during audience shows to regularly check/clean toilets and clear small blockages Cleaners provided with appropriate PPE Audience members to be diverted to alternative toilets inside George Lucas ancillary block where required Studioworks staff/freelancers informed not to attempt to deal with any leaks/overspill from the foul waste tanks Spill kits and PPE available to deal with minor leaks/overspill from portacabins Foul waste tanks regularly checked for damage/plant litter/debris Adequate lighting to cover portacabin toilet blocks and foul waste tanks Included in site Water Hygiene risk assessment with regular legionella sampling and flushing
