The Voice of America's (VOA) first journalistic fact check launched in 2016.

- The website serves as a resource for verifying the increasing volume of disinformation and misinformation globally, with a special focus on authoritarian regimes like those in Russia, China and Iran.
- A team of Polygraph.info journalists at VOA investigates quotes, stories and reports distributed by government officials, government-sponsored media and other high-profile individuals. Reporters separate fact from fiction, add context and debunk false and misleading information.
- Along with fact checks, Polygraph.info produces fact check videos and disinformation analysis, looking at broader trends.
- As part of VOA's News Center, Polygraph.info is produced in English, with most of its fact checks and videos republished by language services within VOA and by various outlets in Europe, Asia, Africa and the Middle East.
- Polygraph.info distributes its content globally using various web and social media platforms.
