ABOUT THE CITEP PROGRAM

The DoD Cyber and Information Technology Exchange Program (CITEP) provides a unique opportunity for DoD and private sector employees working in the information technology (IT) and cybersecurity fields to participate in a temporary detail (between three months and one year) between the two sectors.

CITEP CAREER DEVELOPMENT

This is an opportunity for you to enhance your IT and cybersecurity competencies and technical skills through defined and meaningful experiences at a DoD organization. Throughout the process you will gain exposure of emerging IT and cybersecurity concepts, strategies, private sector best practices and more.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for CITEP you must be able to obtain and maintain the same type, level and adjudication of the security clearance required to perform the duties of the exchange assignment. Applicants must possess the experience, knowledge, and skills required for the exchange opportunity and meet the definition of a high-performing employee in accordance with their organization's performance standards. Lastly, receive an endorsement from their immediate supervisor.
