

Artist records coolest sounds

A SCOTTISH artist has used underwater technology to capture the sounds of a melting glacier by placing a mobile phone linked to a microphone in an Icelandic lagoon.

Embedded deep inside one of the massive chunks of ice from the Jokulsarlon glacier, it will record every sound from the

eerie high-pitched screeches of the moving ice to the sounds of seals and passing wild ducks.

Katie Paterson, 25, from Glasgow, is holding a week-long graduate show at the Slade Gallery in London featuring a mobile phone number, 07758 225698, which lets people listen to the sounds of the melting glaciers.
