Comprehensive Methodology

More than 50,000 individual prices

are collected by a combination of field correspondents and secondary research in each survey round conducted in March and in September.

EIU researchers survey a range of stores

such as supermarkets, mid-priced stores and higher-priced speciality outlets. Prices reflect costs for more than 200 items. These are not recommended retail prices; they are what the paying customer is charged.

Prices are internally vetted before being weighted and compared in US dollars (using exchange rates at the time of the survey) to produce an index between a base city and a host city, where the base city equals 100 and the host city is expressed as a proportion of this sum
