ADAPs provide Food and Drug Administration-approved medications to low-income people with HIV who have limited or no health care coverage. ADAPs may also obtain health care coverage for eligible clients.

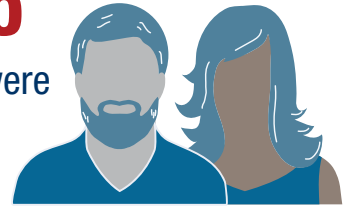
