


2019 VISITOR STATISTICS WASHINGTON, DC

Overseas visitation is for the District of Columbia only, and does not include Mexico or Canada.





VISITOR SPENDING (IN BILLIONS)



TOURISM IMPACT WASHINGTON, DC (DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA)


- If tourism did not exist in Washington, DC, the District would need to generate an average of \$2,920 in local taxes from each of the 307,000 households in DC in order to maintain the current level of tax receipts.
- Travel and tourism spending supports 78,266 jobs annually.
- Travel and tourism jobs support \$4.51 billion in wages.
- Domestic spending was up 4.3% to \$5.9 billion; international spending up 3.5% to \$2.2 billion in 2019.

TOURISM IMPACT WASHINGTON, DC (DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA)

- Each Washington, DC visitor generates about \$331 in expenditures.
- Every 314 visitors creates a new job in Washington, DC.
- Each visitor generates \$183 in wages.
- Each visitor creates about \$36 in local tax receipts.

DOMESTIC VISITATION FORECAST THROUGH 2022 WASHINGTON, DC (DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA)



The baseline forecast for DC's domestic visitor volume shows an expected drop of more than 50% in 2020, rising to 20 million by 2022.

The baseline forecast assumes an effective vaccine or therapeutic available in the first part of 2021 and no additional lockdowns.

METHODOLOGY

VISITOR VOLUME: MMGY TRAVEL INTELLIGENCE (DOMESTIC) AND TRAVEL MARKET INSIGHTS (OVERSEAS)

- Domestic data is collected using an online panel methodology, contacting more than 50,000 distinct U.S. households each month; data is weighted by key demographics to balance the sample to the U.S. population.
- Overseas data comes from the I-94 form for visitors to the U.S. and is supplemented by data from the Survey of International Air Travelers. The data is released by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

VISITOR FORECAST AND ECONOMIC IMPACT: TOURISM ECONOMICS (FORECAST) AND IHS MARKIT (ECONOMIC IMPACT)

 Visitor volume data is combined with economic variables, DC tax collections and other tourism indicators like airport arrivals, transportation statistics and attractions attendance to calculate forecasts and economic impact.
