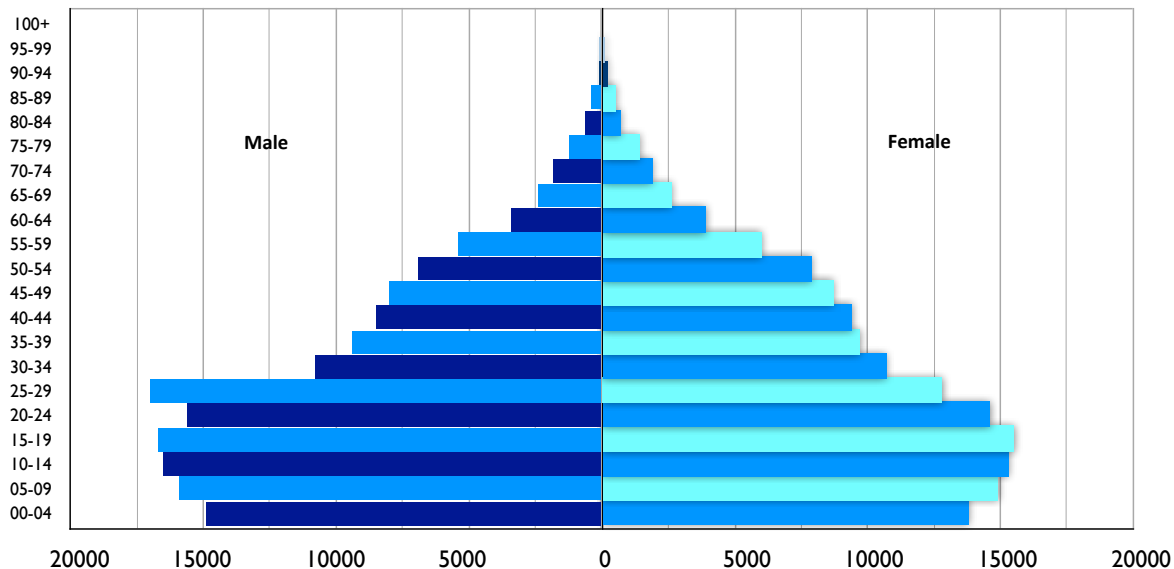

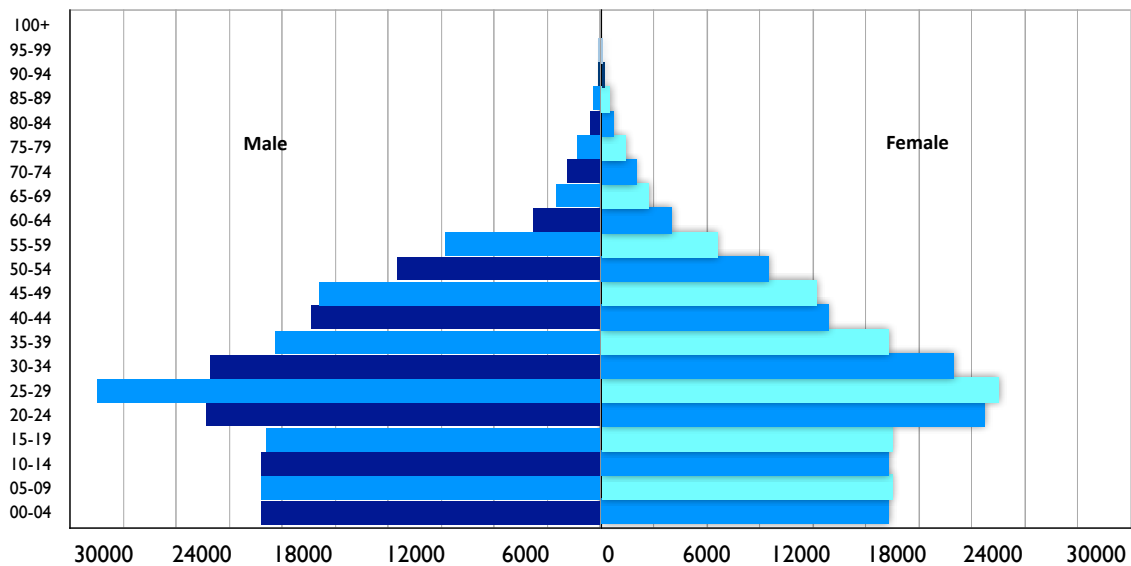

## POPULATION PYRAMID, BRUNEI CITIZENS AND PERMANENT RESIDENTS 2010

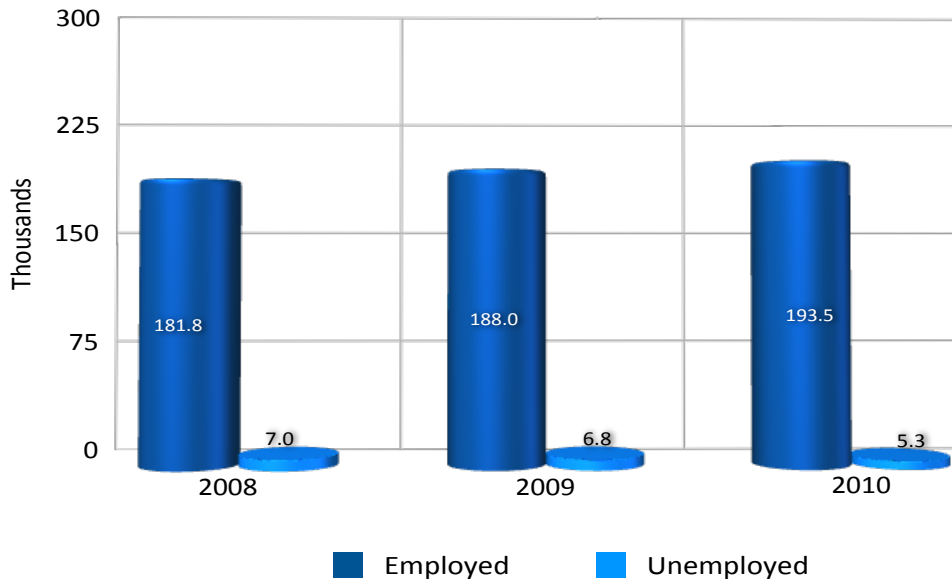


## POPULATION PYRAMID, ALL RESIDENTS 2010

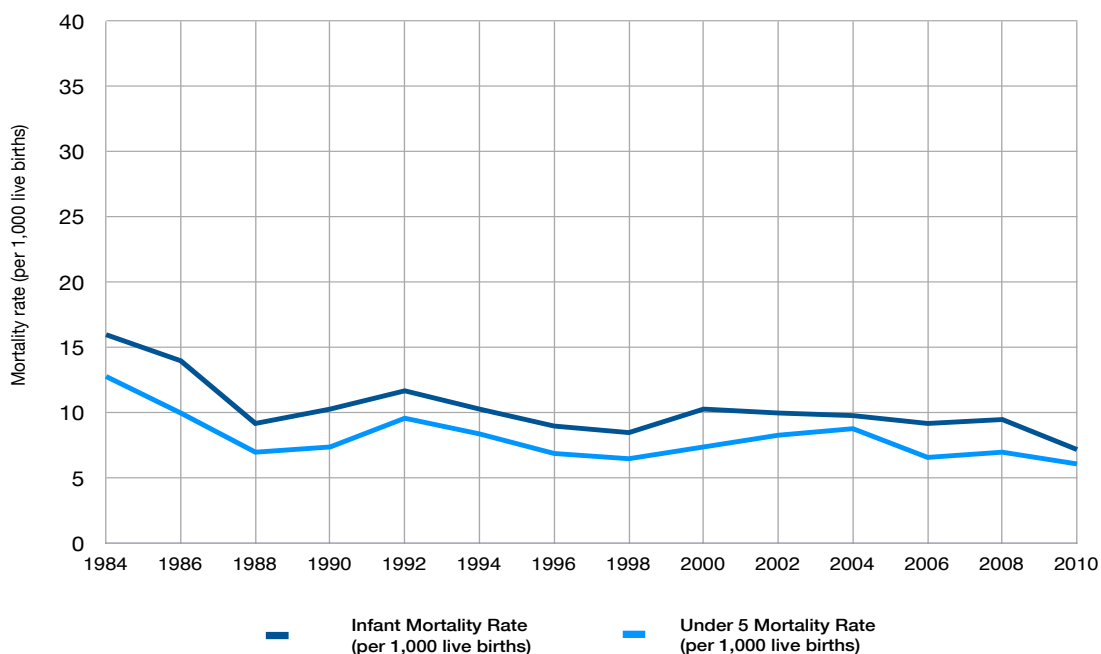
## NUMBER OF EMPLOYED AND UNEMPLOYED

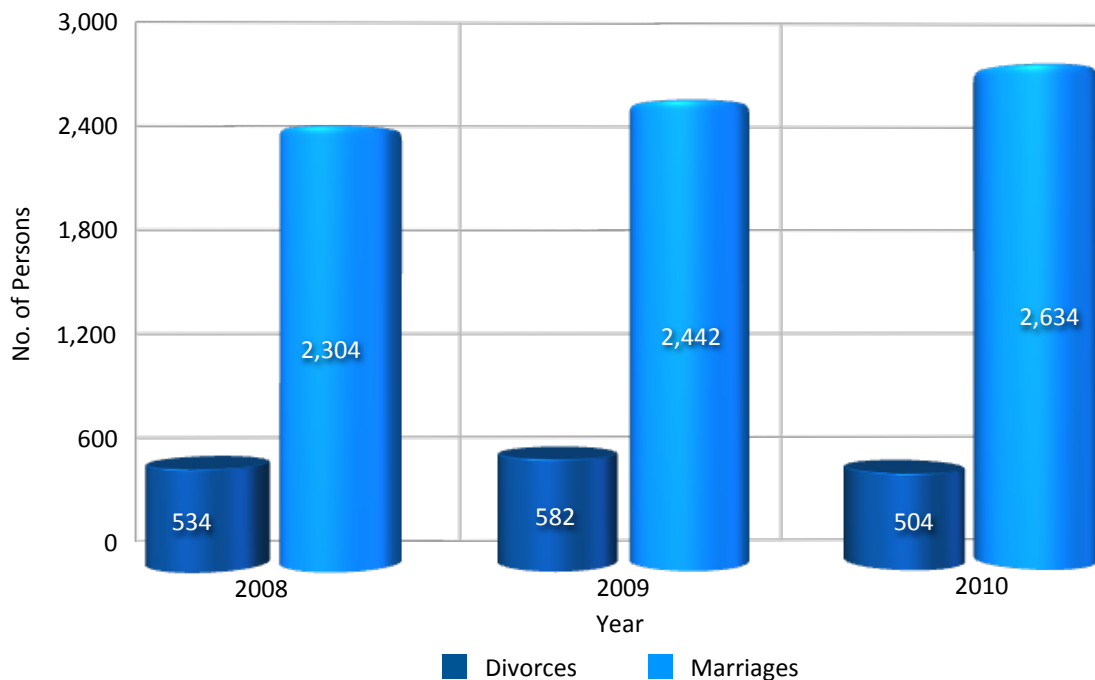

### TOTAL MARRIAGES AND DIVORCES



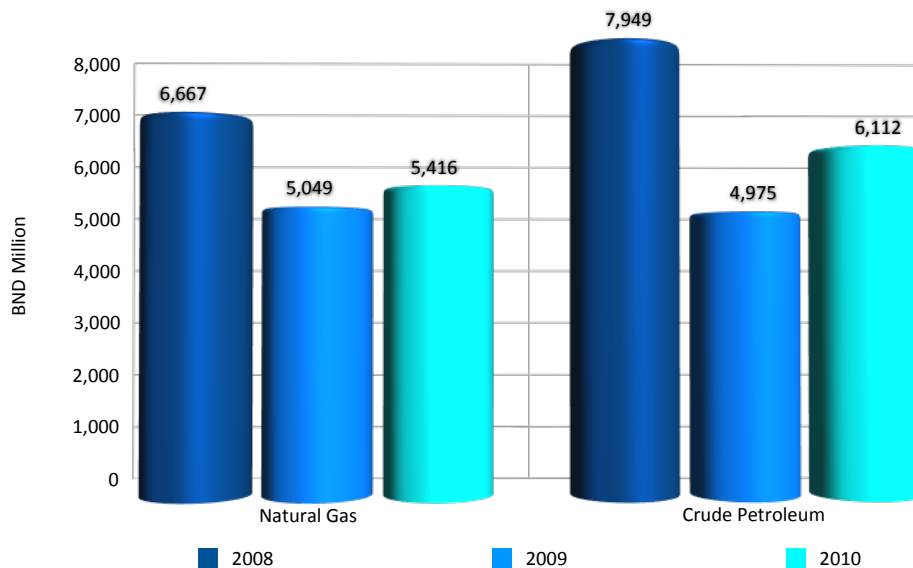

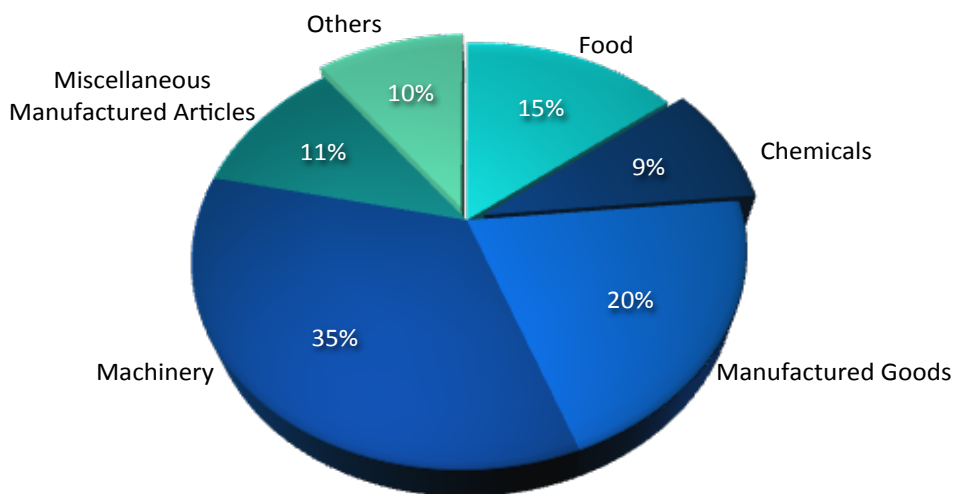

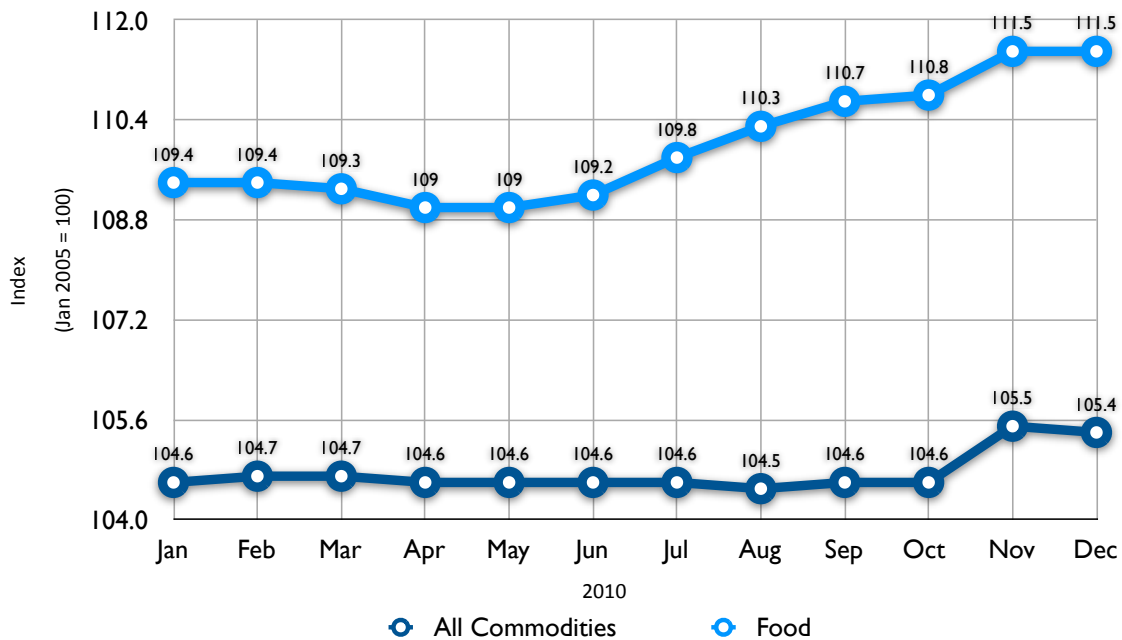


## SHARE OF IMPORTS 2010

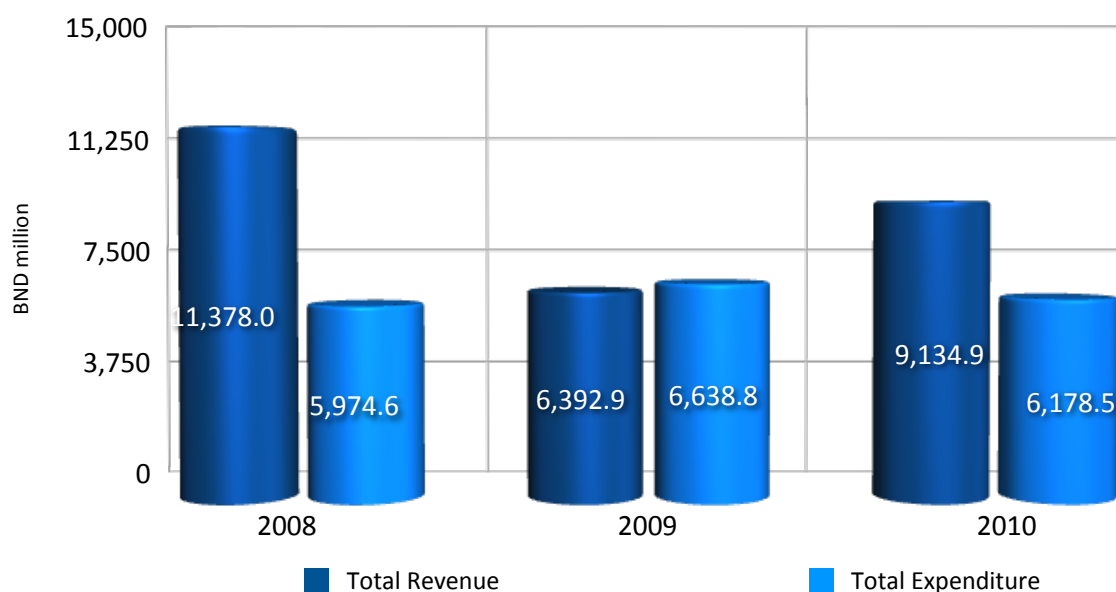

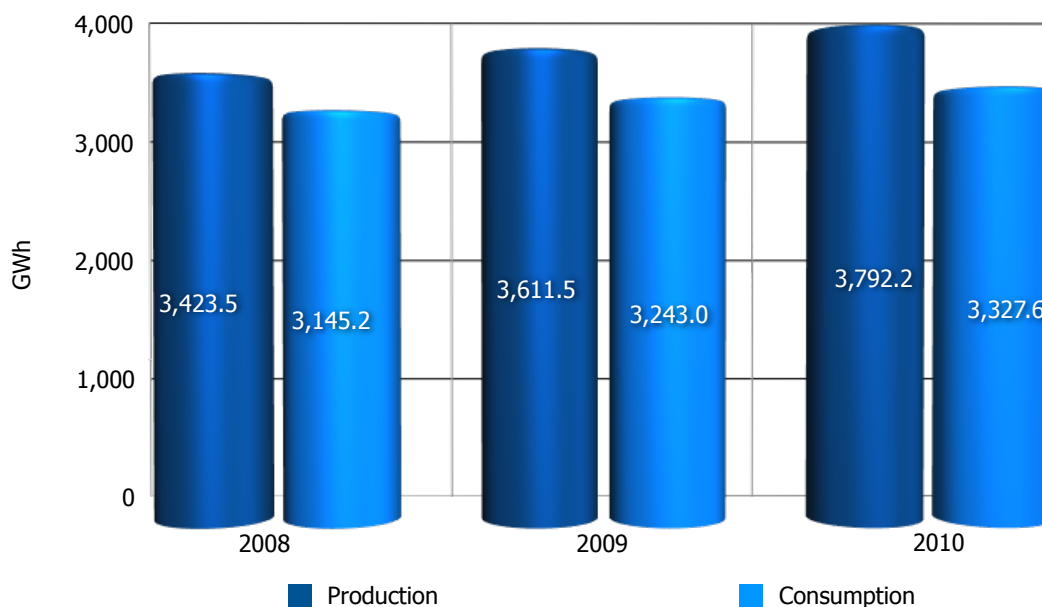

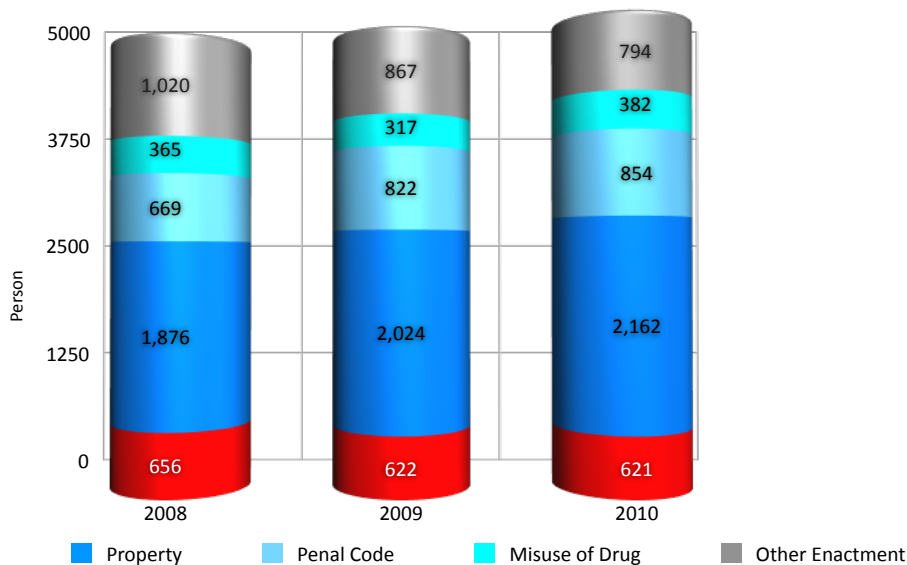
