Key engagement

Pursuit of common interests in multilateral fora, particularly the UN and the Commonwealth.

Outlook

Trade and investment opportunities exist in Belize for Australian businesses, including in agriculture, education, tourism and transport and related industries.

Bilateral relations

Australia and Belize established diplomatic relations in 1982.

Australia's High Commissioner to Trinidad and Tobago has non-resident accreditation to Belize. Belize has an Honorary Consul in Sydney.

Foreign relations

Australia and Belize are members of the Commonwealth, International Maritime Organisation (IMO), World Trade Organisation (WTO) and United Nations (UN).

Australia and Belize are Co-Chairs with Mauritius of the Commonwealth Blue Charter Action Group on Coral Reef Protection and Restoration, and members of the International Coral Reef Initiative.

Belize is a member of the the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), the Association of Caribbean States (ACS), the Africa, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) Group of States, the Organization of American States (OAS) and other regional organisations. It is a member of the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) grouping, which includes small island states in the Caribbean, Pacific and Indian Oceans.
