


High levels of food insecurity, development path reversed	Local fish species go extinct	Agriculture yields fall rapidly	Wheat, rice, maize and soybean production suffers	IMPACTS ON FOOD
470-760 million people at risk; sea level rise of nearly 9 meters	Near-complete melting of the Greenland ice sheet; sea level rise of 7+ meters	Fewer opportunities for infrastructure adaptation; sea level rise of 56cm	Rising sea levels displace 46 million people; sea level rise of 48cm	IMPACTS ON COASTS
Half of all plant and animal species face local extinction	Marine ecosystems may collapse	Virtually all coral reef lost	Coral reefs would decline by 70-90 percent	IMPACTS ON NATURE
