
The NSA Unchained

When probed by Congressional intelligence committees about surveillance under the amended law, intelligence officials admitted the agency had been engaged in "significant and systemic" "overcollection" of Americans

domestic communications.

Government reports confirm that the NSA has violated FISA, but the NSA refuses to release information about these abuses.
