Hedgemead Park

Very steep. For the adventurous!

This attractive 5 acre park owes its existence to a great misfortune which occurred when the houses that originally covered the site were destroyed by a landslide in the 1870's. The layout of the paths and terrain on this park was engineered to prevent the possibility of future landslides.

The park contains many beautiful trees and shrubs, some fine rose displays and a small children's play area.

Steep gradients and steps in this park make it unsuitable for wheelchair users, although the walk shown is generally level.
