An 18th century landscape garden with panoramic views of the city


Prior Park is owned and managed by The National Trust, this beautiful landscape is a haven of peace and tranquillity, offering an enjoyable and invigorating walk of one and half miles, which is very steep in places.

Prior Park is a garden for all seasons, open all year round. Walk through the woodland glades, and step onto the iconic Palladian bridge (one of only 4 in the world), enjoy the wildlife. A great place for a picnic. Prior Park is just a 10 minute bus ride from the city centre, the bus stop is right outside of the garden entrance. Frequency approx, every 20 minutes.
