

On 4 August 2022 the BBC published Terms of Reference for an independent review of its response to claims which have been made about the conduct of former BBC DJ Tim Westwood.

The Review, led by Gemma White KC, would very much like to hear from anyone with knowledge relevant to the Terms of Reference, in particular of:

- (i) Any allegations or concerns about the conduct of Tim Westwood during any time he worked for the BBC, and in particular during the period 1994 to 2013, whether or not the allegations or concerns were raised with the BBC at the time;
- (ii) BBC knowledge of any such allegations or concerns;
- (iii) Any response by the BBC to allegations or concerns which were raised and/or otherwise known about; and
- (iv) Any reasons for which allegations or concerns were not raised with the BBC.

Anyone who contributes to the Review can ask that their identity or all or part of any evidence they provide are not shared with anyone else, including with the BBC. Such requests will be agreed by Gemma White where appropriate to do so.
