
Master Operating Plan (MOP)

Overview of Processes



Cargo iQ has developed a Master Operating Plan (MOP) which describes the movement of a shipment and information from shipper to consignee in 19 key steps.





Definitions

PUP – Pick Up at / from Shipper

REW - Received Export Warehouse

DEW - Departed Export Warehouse

REH - Received Export Hub

DEH - Departed Export Hub

FWB - (Electronic) Freight Waybill

FOH - Freight On Hand

RCS – Ready for Carriage

FOW - Freight out Warehouse

DEP - Departed

ARR - Arrived

FIW - Freight in Warehouse

RCF - Received Cargo from Flight

NFD - Notified for Delivery

DLV - Delivered Destination Airport

RIH - Received Import Hub

DIH - Departed Import Hub

RIW - Received Import Warehouse

OFD – Out for Delivery

TPN – Third Party Notification

POD - Proof of Delivery










Lane view for airline DEMO





