#### **Notice to Public of Termination of Peak Resources - Charlotte**

Notice is hereby given that on March 29, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and **Peak Resources - Charlotte (3223 Central Avenue, Charlotte, North Carolina 28205)**. CMS has determined that Peak Resources - Charlotte has failed to substantially comply with Medicare and Medicaid health and safety participation requirements.

Peak Resources - Charlotte has been notified that CMS will cease to pay for skilled nursing facility services furnished to Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries admitted to Peak Resources - Charlotte after December 29, 2022. However, payment for services rendered to beneficiaries admitted on or before December 29, 2022, may continue for up to 30 calendar days after March 29, 2023.

While we understand the relocation of residents can be challenging for all parties involved, CMS prioritizes resident safety and care quality. We are closely monitoring the relocation of residents to other facilities.
