SUBJECT: Release of Medical Loss Ratio (MLR) Data Form and Filing Instructions for

Contract Year 2020

Each Medicare Advantage (MA) Organization, Cost Plan, and Part D Plan Sponsor is required to submit MLR information to CMS for each contract year pursuant to the regulations at 42 CFR §§ 422.2460 and 423.2460. This memorandum announces the release of the MLR Data Form and filing instructions for Contract Year (CY) 2020.

The MLR Data Form and filing instructions for CY 2020 may be obtained in the Health Plan Management System (HPMS) beginning Friday June 25th 2021 at: HPMS Home > Plan Bids > Medical Loss Ratio > CY2020.

The expected timeline for CY 2020 MLR submission is as follows. Another memorandum will be released later this year to serve as a reminder and to confirm the CY 2020 MLR timeline.

- The upload functionality for completed CY 2020 MLR Data Forms will be available in HPMS beginning Friday, January 7, 2022.
- CY 2020 MLR Data Forms must be submitted in HPMS by 11:59 PM Pacific Standard Time (PST) on Friday, February 4, 2022.
- The attestation functionality for CY 2020 MLR Data Forms will be available in HPMS beginning Monday, February 7, 2022.
- CY 2020 MLR attestations must be submitted in HPMS by 11:59 PM Pacific Standard Time (PST) on Wednesday, February 16, 2022.
