Disclaimer:

In the interest of equal treatment of applicants, the Frontex cannot issue a prior opinion on the eligibility of an applicant, an action or specific activities.

Question 1

Q: Does the limitation regarding the number of applications concern only the role of consortium coordinator? E.g. can one institution submit an application as coordinator, and act as other applicant in two other applications represented by another entity?

A: According to point 6.1 of the CFP 'One institution/entity (in the same or a different consortium) may submit up to two applications, one for each action.'

It is Frontex intention to allow one institution/entity the submission of maximum two applications regardless of the role in the consortium (coordinator or other applicant).

Question 2

Q: Regarding Action 1 'Training Courses'
Can one institution apply for the development of training course(s) in one application, and for the delivery of training course(s) in another application?

A: According to point 6.1 of the CFP 'One institution/entity (in the same or a different consortium) may submit up to two applications, **one for each action.**'

Thus, since both topics - development and delivery of training courses fall under Action 1, the answer would be NO. One entity cannot submit two applications for the same action.

Question 3

Q: Who should contribute the 5% of the entire sum? Is it only the coordinator or should this amount be split between partners?

A: It is up to the applicants to propose the sources of funding and the breakdown. As indicated in the form 'Sources of funding of the action' (which needs to be submitted as annex to the application), there could be various sources, and for Frontex it is important that they sum up to a minimum of 5% of the proposed project budget.

Question 4

Q: Regarding Action 2 'Mobility and Exchange'
Can a Teacher Mobility proposal include as participants only teachers from border guard schools, without learners (in the meaning of students)?

A: It is Frontex intention to fund mobility and exchange programmes for both learners and training staff (not only for teachers) under one project. However, Frontex will also accept proposals covering only training staff mobility.
