**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the Order in lieu of indictment in the case No. IT-03-67-T/R77.1, issued confidentially by the Trial Chamber on 13 May 2008;

**NOTING** that Ljubiša Petković was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 28 May 2008;

**NOTING** the Order issued on 23 May 2008 by the Vice-President of the Tribunal, acting on behalf of the President of the Tribunal, assigning the case against Ljubiša Petković (“Accused”) to Trial Chamber III;

**NOTING** the Order issued by the President of Trial Chamber III on 28 May 2008, assigning this Trial Chamber to these proceedings;

**NOTING** the Order issued on 28 May 2008 by the Trial Chamber, designating Judge Flavia Lattanzi as judge of Trial Chamber III for the purpose of the initial appearance of the Accused;

**NOTING** that the initial appearance of the Accused has been scheduled for Thursday 29 May 2008 at 14.15 in Courtroom II;

**HAVING CONSIDERED** the request of certain members of the press;

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that, subject to any further order of the Trial Chamber:


1. the taking of still photographs by designated press photographers at the commencement of all proceedings in this matter is authorised as directed by the Chief of Security of the Tribunal’s Security Service; and
2. the release of the audio-visual record of all open sessions in this case is permitted as provided by the Registrar of the Tribunal.
