DECISION ON PROSECUTION'S URGENT REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED WORD LIMIT FOR PROSECUTION'S RESPONSE TO TRIAL CHAMBER'S INVITATION PURSUANT TO RULE 73 bis(D)

I, Krister Thelin, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

BEING SEISED of the "Prosecution's urgent request for leave to exceed word limit for Prosecution's response to Trial Chamber's invitation pursuant to Rule 73bis(D)", filed publicly on 15 May 2008 ("Request"), whereby the Prosecution requests leave to file its response to the Trial Chamber's invitation not exceeding 3,500 words;¹

RECALLING the Trial Chamber's invitation to the Prosecution pursuant to Rule 73 bis (D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;²

NOTING that, pursuant to the "Practice direction on the length of briefs and motions" ("Practice Direction"), a party must seek authorisation in advance from the Chamber to exceed the word limits and must provide an explanation of the exceptional circumstances that necessitate the oversized filing;³

CONSIDERING the Prosecution's submissions concerning the existence of exceptional circumstances, including the significant nature of the Trial Chamber's invitation and the impact it will have on the presentation of the Prosecution's case;⁴

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 and Article 7 of the Practice Direction;

GRANT the Request.
