## Abisko – Hike to Trollsjön

An exhilarating hike you will never forget. Great forces have been at work on Kärkevagge, creating high cliffs, boulder fields and delta formations. This is a fairytale landscape in which barren mountain terrain and fields of colorful alpine flowers are side by side - a paradise for hikers.

Our route takes us through a beautiful birch forest and continues up over bare areas of primary rock, reminding you of pre-historic ages. Then we come to a majestic valley called Kärkevagge. The path meanders over eroded rock features formed by the most recent ice age. Arriving at Geargejávri, Trollsjön, you will marvel at the lake which glitters like fire in the sun. Lunch tastes really good after our final ascent. Relax for a while, take a dip, or just stroll around and enjoy the atmosphere before we return along the outflow of this enchanting lake.

The hike to Geargejávri, Trollsjön is 6 km long, and has an elevation gain of 400 meters, in total the hike ends up at 12 km with +-400 meters of elevation. The path is often wet and slippery and that is why we recommend that you wear hiking boots.
