

The agreement also includes access to content in the most recent Journals Collections. Social sharing This Read and Publish agreement covers the Article Processing Charges (APCs), for corresponding authors affiliated with licensed institutions in subscription-based journals that offer hybrid Open Access. The agreement for unlimited Open Access publishing Open access journals will commence on 1 January 2019. Articles submitted by eligible corresponding authors qualify for Open Access publishing under this agreement upon the date the article is processed by RightsLink, from or after 1 January 2019 through 31 December 2021. 


#### Authors navigates to the submission system from the journal's homepage on Cambridge Core
