3. Non-degree students are not eligible to take UCDHSC independent study or internship courses without specific permission from the Dean of the College of the course.
4. Non-degree students seeking to change to degree status must meet the admission requirements as defined by the college and the Office of Admissions.
5. Non-degree students seeking to change to degree status are subject to the non-degree credit limit and resident credit policies of the school or college offering the degree.

### **Signature Authority**

Dean's permission or signature authority may be required for non-degree students carrying out specific academic procedures. Dean's signature authority refers to the Dean or the Dean's designee which is typically an assistant or associate dean.

1. Prior to and during the semester/term, the Dean's signature authority resides with the Dean of the college in which the course is rostered. If a student is registered for courses across colleges, the authority resides with the Dean of the college for each respective course.
2. After the completion of the semester/term, the Dean's signature authority resides with the Dean of the college in which the course is rostered. If a student is registered for courses across colleges, the authority resides with the Dean of the college for each respective course. This post-semester authority is required for grade appeals, retroactive drop/add, and retroactive withdrawals.
